The Department of Science and Technology-Science Education Institute (DOST-SEI) will be holding the 8th Indie-*Siyensya* Filmmaking Competition, with the theme, Science and Filipino Culture: *Siyensya sa Kultura, Kultura sa Siyensya*, in various Cinematheque Centers of the Film Development Council of the Philippines (FDCP) and through its official online channel, JuanFlix. This is scheduled from March to December 2024.

The Indie-*Siyensya* is a science filmmaking competition that aims to develop a culture of science among youth using film as a medium. 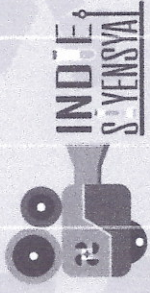
The target participants are high school learners from public and private schools.

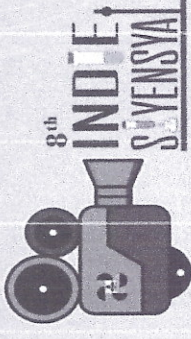
