MEDIA ADVISORY

PHLPost would like to invite every interested individual to join the Stamp Design Contest. This contest is open to high school and college students, artists, designers, illustrators, and other interested individuals anchored on the theme "150 Years of Enabling Communication and Empowering People Across Nations".

This activity aims to produce and discover more talented Filipinos in the field of stamp designing.

COMPETITION RULES

Artworks must be in canvas. A printed version of the artwork must be submitted as well.

The design must interpret the theme "150 Years of Enabling Communication and Empowering People Across Nations."

- A. Limit of one painting from each artist.
- B. Artworks may be in portrait or landscape format.
- C. The size of the artwork should be 10 x 14 inches or 14 x 10 inches (Note the actual stamp size is 35 x 50 mm or 50 x 35 mm in portrait or landscape format)
- D. Artworks are not limited by color restrictions; artists are free to use any colors they choose.
- E. The artwork or design shall NOT incorporate the text of the theme, denomination of the stamp, year of issue and the word "PILIPINAS"
- F. Brief narrative interpretation must accompany each entry, placed in a brown envelope. It should be printed on letter-size bond paper (8" x 11") and include the artist's full name, school address/affiliation, email address, and contact numbers.

CRITERIA FOR JUDGING

1. All entries will undergo a preliminary judging.
2. Final judging will be composed of three (3) judges of undisputable competence. The decision of the panel of judges is final and not subject to appeal.
3. The criteria for judging are (subject to change), as follows:

a. Relevance to the Theme	50%
b. Originality	20%
c. Visual Impact	15%
d. Artist method/design	15%

SUBMISSION OF ENTRIES

1. The submission of entries will commence on 15 June of 2024 and will last until 15 July 2024.



2. A digital version of the artwork submitted through email to philatelydivision2023@gmail.com. The file must be in JPEG format. Include the narrative brief as well in the email.
3. A printed version along with the narrative brief must be submitted.

Guidelines for the printed version:

Dye based printing or colored laser printing on paper. Size should be 10 x 14 inches or 14 x 10 inches.

4. Participants may submit their artwork or design personally and may ONLY be submitted via **Domestic Express Mail Service (DEMS)** to:

5. Entries sent thru private couriers like LBC, DHL, 2Go, JRS Express, et. Al. shall be automatically **DISQUALIFIED**.
6. All winning entries shall automatically become the property of the Philippine Postal Corporation (PHLPost).
7. Artists of non-winning entries may retrieve their artworks a week after the announcement of winners, at their own cost.

PRIZES

The winning designs will be featured in official stamps to be issued and launched on 9 October 2024 by PHLPost for national and international circulation.

Four (4) winners will be awarded P50,000 each + Souvenir Frame.
