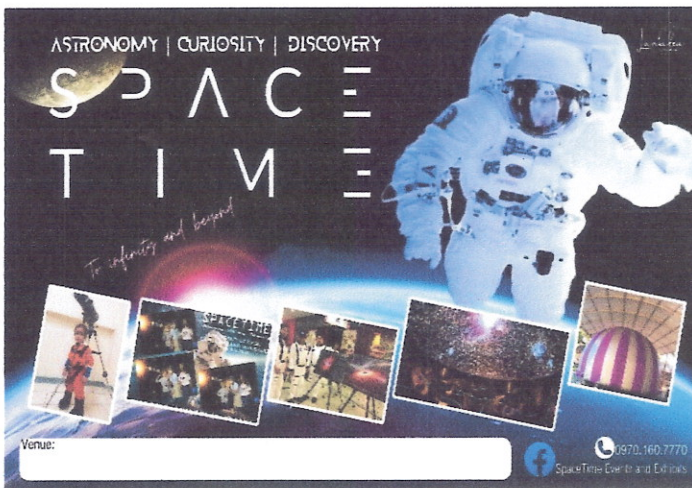

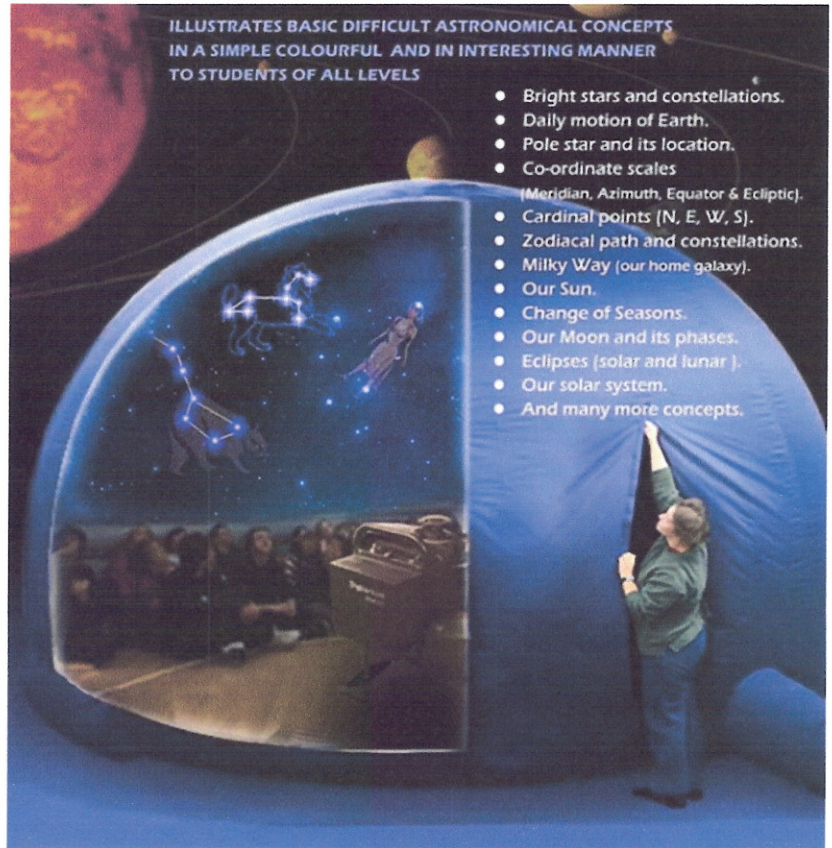

Station 2: PHOTOBOOTH (Special Space Effects)



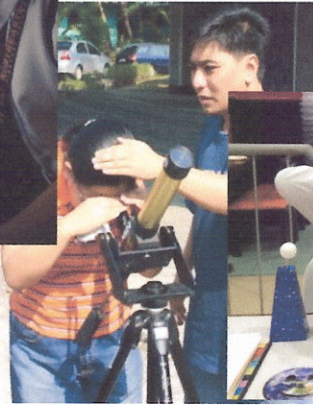
