SUBJECT : **REQUEST FOR PARTICIPANTS AND INVITATION FOR THE BULLYING PREVENTION PROGRAM**

DATE : August 15, 2024

In line with Sections 4 and 13 of DepEd Order No. 55, s. 2013 or the "Implementing Rules and Regulations (IRR) of Republic Act (RA) No. 10627 otherwise known as the Anti-Bullying Act of 2013," mandates all schools to adopt an Anti-Bullying Policy¹.

The Learner Rights and Protection Office (LRPO) as part of its mandate of implementing preventive interventions to address violence, abuse, *bullying*, and exploitation in schools and other learning environment, will be conducting its *Bullying Prevention Program*. The goal is to develop and/or update the localized anti-bullying policy in schools within their respective region. Moreover, the *Bullying Prevention Program* aims to strengthen the participants' understanding of the law, effects of bullying, and their roles to address the issue.

In line therewith, may we invite the regional heads to identify representatives who will participate in the first roll-out of the *Bullying Prevention Program*, in consideration of the goal of developing a localized anti-bullying policy, may we request that selected participants form part of the: (1) Regional Permanent Learner Rights and Protection (LRP) focal personnel, (2) Regional Alternate LRP focal

¹ DepEd Order No. 55, s. 2013, Section 4. Adoption of Anti-Bullying Policies

All public and private kindergarten, elementary, and secondary schools shall adopt policies to address the existence of bullying in their respective institutions. Such policies shall be regularly updated and, at a minimum, shall include provisions on prohibited acts, prevention and intervention programs, mechanisms and procedures.

Section 13. Reporting Requirement

All private and public kindergarten, elementary, and secondary schools shall submit a copy of their child protection or anti-bullying policy to the Division Office within six (6) months from the effectivity of this IRR. They shall submit to the Division Office within the first week of each school year a report on relevant information and statistics on bullying and retaliation from the preceding school year. In addition to the requirements for an application for a permit to operate and/or recognition as prescribed by the existing rules of the Department, private schools shall submit a child protection or anti-bullying policy to the Regional Director. The Regional Director shall review the policy to ensure that it is consistent with the Act and this IRR.

Accordingly, in line with the learners' right to participation, the LRPO requests to invite selected members of the Regional Federation of the Supreme Elementary Learner Government (SELG) and Supreme Secondary Learner Government (SSLG) from DepEd Region VI to participate in the crafting of a Code of Conduct for Learners. Their presence will only be required for one day, provided that there will be no disruption of classes.

Moreover, as part of the *Bullying Prevention Program*, the LRPO in partnership with the Stairway Foundation Inc., has designed an application for schools, especially for our Child Protection Committees (CPCs), to better address reported learner rights and protection concerns. The said application/system will be pilot-tested in Region VI.

The *Bullying Prevention Program* for Visayas Cluster is scheduled on September 3-6, 2024, in the Province of Iloilo. Travel expenses of the participants shall be charged to the Regional LRP funds and/or local funds, subject to the usual accounting and auditing rules and regulations.
