



SUBJECT : **PROVINCIAL LAUNCHING OF SCHOOL BASED IMMUNIZATION PROGRAM**

1. Pursuant to DOH Department Memorandum No. 2024-0250 and DepEd DM OUOPS-2024-03-06789 and Division Memo No. 648, s.2024 titled “INTERIM GUIDELINES ON THE RESUMPTION OF SCHOOL-BASED IMMUNIZATION (SBI) PROGRAM AFTER THE COVID-19 PANDEMIC” you are hereby directed to attend the **Provincial Launching of the School Based Immunization Program on October 1, 2024 (Tuesday) at Tagbilaran City Hall Atrium, Tagbilaran City, Bohol at 8:00 in the morning.**

2. The Grade 1 and Grade 7 learners will be provided with Measles-Rubella (MR) and Tetanus-Diphtheria (Td) vaccines and the Grade 4 female learners will be provided with Humanpapilloma Virus (HPV) vaccine by the Tagbilaran City Health Office.

3. The following schools are to identify learners who will **voluntarily** submit to the ceremonial immunization:

Tagbilaran City Central Elementary School	Ten (10) male and female Grade 1 Learners Ten (10) female Grade 4 Learners
Dr. Cecilio Putong National High School-JHS	Ten (10) male and female Grade 7 Learners

4. A duly signed Parent’s consent is required and will be collected upon arrival to the venue. Grade 1 and Grade 4 learners must be accompanied by their parent/guardian while Grade 7 learners are to be accompanied by the principal and their school nurse.
