2. CREATIVE ART CONTEST (School Category) for Tagbilaran Schools only)

GUIDELINES:

1. A maximum of 15 contestants will be allowed to participate, regardless of school level (High School and Senior High School)
2. Participants must use organically or naturally grown farm produce (e.g., fruits, vegetables, grains, twigs, leaves, etc.) as the primary medium for their artwork. They are responsible for sourcing and securing their own materials for the contest.
3. Participants must create their artwork on a ½-sized illustration board, ensuring the design fits within these dimensions."
4. The theme for the contest is "*Panginabuhiang Organiko, Kaugmaong OK Kaayo*". Artwork should reflect the principles of organic farming and the beauty of farm produce.
5. Along with the artwork, a brief description explaining the concept and materials used must be submitted.
6. Participants are given a total of 2 hours to complete their final artwork.
7. Official Winning Entries shall deemed properties of the management.
8. Decision of the Judges is final and unappealable.
