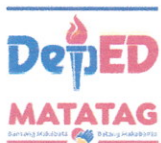

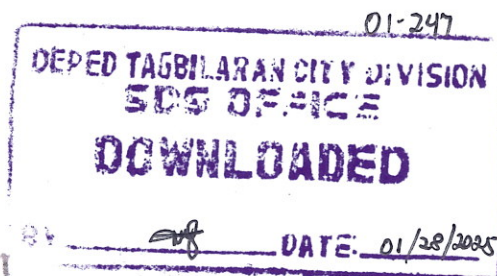

The FELTA Multi-Media Inc. will conduct the 14th First Lego League Philippines at Dr. Yanga's Colleges Inc., Bocaue, Bulacan on February 8, 2025. The conference activity aims to

1. support the Philippines' aggressive campaign towards the promotion of science and technology interests among the youth, particularly, in Robotics as one of the new alternative media of effective learning;
2. integrate the interplay of instructivism and constructivism as an effective medium in teaching Robotics; and
3. offer new perspectives and great opportunities related to the rising demands of Robotics on the local and international scene.

The activity consists of three categories:

Category	Description	Participants	Team Composition
Discover	Ignite natural curiosity and build habits of learning with hands-on activities in the classroom and at home using Lego Duplo Bricks.	Pre-K-Grade 1	Maximum of eight members and two coaches per school
Explore	Focus on the fundamentals of engineering and explore real-world problems, learn to design and code, and create unique solutions made with Lego bricks, powered by a Lego Education robot.	Grades 2-4	Maximum of six members and two coaches per school
Challenge	Engage in research, problem-solving, coding, and engineering—building and programming a Lego robot that navigates the missions of a robot game and participate in a research project to identify and solve relevant real-world problems.	Grades 4-10	Maximum of 10 members and two coaches per school

Participation of learners and teachers from public and private schools shall be purely voluntary and will not hamper instructional time in compliance with the provisions of DepEd Order (DO) No. 009, s. 2024 titled Implementing Guidelines on the School Calendar and Activities for the School Year 2024-2025 and DO 9, s. 2005 titled Instituting Measures to Increase Engaged Time-on-Task and Ensuring Compliance Therewith and the policy on off-campus activities stated in DO 66, s. 2017.
