**ANNOUNCING THE 2025 CENTRAL VISAYAS REGIONAL ATHLETIC ASSOCIATION  
(CVIRAA) SPORTS MEET AND ITS SCHEDULE OF ACTIVITIES**

1. The Department of Education (DepEd) Region VII officially announces the conduct of the **2025 Central Visayas Regional Athletic Association (CVIRAA) Sports Meet** on March 11-16, 2025, at Bayawan City.
2. The annual scholastic multi-sport regional competition shall be hosted by the local government unit (LGU) of Bayawan City together with DepEd Division of Bayawan City. The event shall be participated by the twenty (20) division athletic associations.
3. This year's CVIRAA Meet shall continue to adopt the "Winner-Take All Policy" for team sports (Basketball, Baseball, Softball, Futsal, Sepak Takraw and Volleyball) and the Qualifying Standards for measurable sports such as Athletics, Swimming, and Archery.
4. Any expenses incurred by the Schools Division Offices (SDOs) relative to its participation, management, and involvement in the CVIRAA Meet, including the Personal Accident Insurance (PAI) of the whole delegation, shall be charged against MOOE/Special Education Fund (SEF)/Fund Support for Sports/local and other available funds, subject to the proper accounting and auditing rules and regulations.
5. As agreed during the Management Committee Meeting conducted last January 31, 2025, the SDOs shall:
  - a. provide Financial Assistance to the Host Division in the amount of PhP 10,000.00 per division;
  - b. be responsible for their own delegation's amenities/supplies like sleeping mats/foams, beddings, etc., transportation, and enhancement of facilities (like kitchen, mess halls, additional shower rooms, drainage, etc.). The hosts (LGU, SDO, and the billeting schools) may offer their available amenities to the delegation.
6. In view thereof, the Schools Division Superintendents are hereby enjoined to support and prepare a plan of action for their division delegation's participation.



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7. For proper coordination and smooth conduct of the CVIRAA Meet, the following activities should be observed:
