SAULOG QUIZ BEE English, Science & Mathematics Category

Guidelines and Mechanics

1. The competition is open to all officially enrolled Junior High School students from public and private schools in Tagbilaran City.
2. There will only be 1 team per school.
3. Each team is composed of 4 students: one student for each for Grades 7, 8, 9 and 10.
4. Each team will have 1 official coach who must be a faculty member of the school.
5. Teams will register at the **City Government of Tagbilaran-City Events, Culture and Arts Office-CECAO** and look for **Ms. Cristine Berioso** or you may contact her at mobile number **0956-395-4127** not later than **March 06, 2025**. The following documents are required to be submitted: valid school IDs of the students and coaches; and endorsement from the school principal. Only the registered teams can participate in the quiz bee.
6. Participants shall wear their school uniforms and IDs during the contest.
7. The quiz bee will be divided into 3 rounds: easy, average and difficult. The following are the corresponding number of items, points and time allotment for answering each item per segment:

Segments	Number of Items	Points	Time Allotment
Easy	15	1	20 seconds
Average	10	3	30 seconds
Difficult	10	5	60 seconds

8. The questions will be given in multiple choice form or identification.
9. The use of calculators is allowed.
10. Each team shall be provided by the City Government of Tagbilaran with laptop, white board, markers, papers and pens.
11. Points all throughout the quiz bee will be cumulative.
12. The questions will be flashed on their laptops and will be read twice by the quizmaster.
13. All participants will have to wait for the signal from the quizmaster before answering the questions. Automatically, the time limit will begin with the word "GO" by the quizmaster.
14. When time is up, the participants must have encoded their answers on the laptop. Upon ringing of the buzzer, the system will automatically lock their laptop and no one can anymore encode.
15. The quizmaster shall read the team that got the correct answer.
16. Questions and protests from the participants regarding the answer to the items will be entertained. If a protest will arise, only the participants may raise their complaints to the quizmaster, and will be addressed to the Board of Judges. Questions and protests must be raised before the next question is read; otherwise, they will be considered invalid. The decision of the Board of Judges is final and irrevocable.
17. In case of tie, a clincher round with 3 difficult questions will be done among the participating teams.
18. The top 3 teams with the highest scores shall be declared as Champion, First Placer and Second Placer respectively.
19. All participating schools, contestants and their coaches shall receive a Certificate of Participation.
20. Winning teams and coaches shall receive Certificates of Recognition, medals and cash prizes. The following are the cash prizes:
