




SUBJECT : **COUNCIL SCOUT YOUTH FORUM**

1. Announcing the conduct of the Council Scout Youth Forum on March 7-9, 2025 at Roxas Park Elementary School, Calma, Garcia-Hernandez, Bohol.
2. The forum aims to:
 - i. Orient our scouts in parliamentary procedures as young leaders in our communities.
 - ii. Provide them an opportunity to express their ideas on the current issues of the country.
 - iii. Elect scout representatives to the Council Executive Board and to the National Scout Youth Forum for the year 2025.
3. Each district is encouraged to send most qualified scouts from the elementary and secondary who must be duly registered Boy or Senior Scouts of ages 11-18 years old, with good scholastic record and can speak English and Filipino fluently.
4. A registration fee of One Thousand Five Hundred Pesos (P 1,500.00) per participant will be collected for the cost of meals/snacks (from breakfast on March 8 until PM snacks of March 9, 2025), forum materials and documentation expenses. Registration, transportation and other related expenses of participants can be charge to the MOOE, SEF, School/District Scouting Funds or to any other available local school funds subject to its availability and in accordance with the existing auditing and accounting guidelines.
5. All participants must report at the venue in scout uniform at 7:00 o'clock in the evening of March 7, 2024 for the opening program, groupings and orientation.
6. Prior to the activity will an online orientation and giving of assignments on March 1, 2025 from 9:00am - 12:00nn. All forum participants are required to participate.
