In this regard, we kindly request your support in sending the participants from both private and public schools in the Tagbilaran City Schools Division to attend the full-day event.

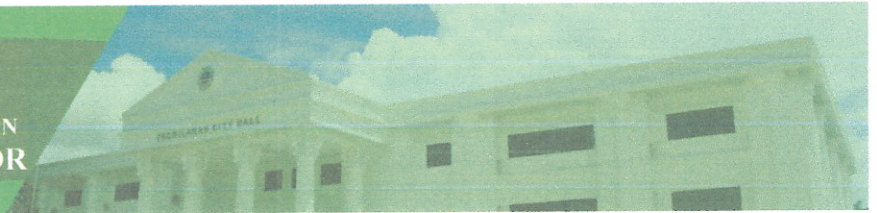

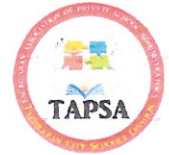
