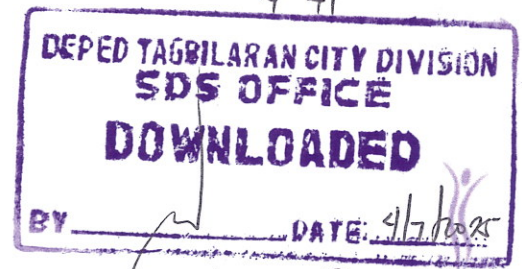

The course critically examines the centrality of gender equality in international human rights instruments. It takes gender as a broad category denoting the diversity of human bodies and experiences related to identity, sexual orientation, age, class, race, ethnicity. These comprise intersectional and structural grounds of inequality and discrimination that result in human rights violation. IWHRG utilizes an interdisciplinary and practical approach to recognize the complex dynamics of gender equality and international human rights, and how to promote and enhance both in everyday life.

4) Gender Sexuality, Student and Youth Wellbeing (GSSYW)

July 22-25, 2025, 4-day training

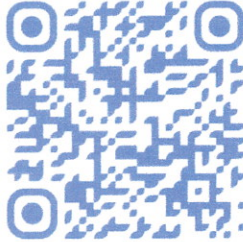
