1. Pursuant to BSP-Bohol Council Memorandum No.10, s. 2025 dated April 2, 2025, this office announces the conduct of the **Survival & Advancement Camps and Unit Leaders Conference** on **April 23-25, 2025** at **Roxas Park, Calma, Garcia-Hernandez, Bohol**.

3. Teaching and non-teaching participants shall be granted with service credits/ Compensatory Time Off (CTO), whichever is applicable, in accordance with the existing rules and regulations.

SUBJECT : **SURVIVAL & ADVANCEMENT CAMPS AND UNIT LEADERS CONFERENCE**


1. The Bohol Council, Boy Scouts of the Philippines is happy to announce the conduct of the Survival and Advancement Camp on April 23-25, 2025 at Roxas Park, Calma, Garcia-Hernandez, Bohol.
2. The camp aims to give opportunities to aspiring scouts to achieve their desired rank in the BSP Advancement Ladder and develop in themselves useful life skills.
3. Registration fee for the cost of meals/snacks and activity materials will be One Thousand Eight Hundred Pesos (P 1,800.00). Registration, transportation and other incidental expenses related to participation can be charge to the MOOE, SEF or to any other available local funds subject to its availability and the usual accounting and auditing procedures.
4. Qualified to participate are duly registered aspiring Senior Scouts. Participants are categorized into two levels based on their knowledge and skill proficiency.
 - a. Advancement Camp - The camp is open to Senior Scouts with basic knowledge in compass reading, basic swimming, and understanding Morse Code, even if it's just memorization. They should also know simple first aid and basic knot-tying. This level aims to help them improve their skills and prepare for more advanced scouting.
 - b. Survival Camp - Scouts in this category possess an advanced understanding of scouting principles and practical skills. They must demonstrate
 - Compass Reading: Accurate use of compass and map-reading.
 - Swimming: Ability to perform swimming strokes and lifesaving skills
 - Morse Code: Transmitting and decoding skills.
 - First Aid procedures and emergency response
 - Knot Tying: Proficiency in basic and advanced knots and its uses.
 - Survival Skills (cooking, shelter making, etc...)
5. Assembly time at the venue will be at exactly 8:00 o'clock in the morning on the first day of the above-mentioned schedule in scout uniform.

6. These will all be live-in trainings. Thus, all participants are advised to bring the following:
 - a. Parent's consent
 - b. Scout's Uniform (Type A & B)
 - c. extra T-shirts, personal belongings & toiletries
 - d. beddings/mess kit
 - e. individual dome tent with sleeping gears
 - f. swimming attire
 - g. string for knot tying
 - h. compass, knife/bolo
 - i. notebook and ballpen
7. For Safety purposes, we highly request that participating scouts without accompanying unit leaders must be accompanied their parent or a reliable adult in going to the venue and shall be also fetched after the activity.
8. We are humbly requesting all District Field Commissioners/School BSP Coordinators and Unit Leaders to help us disseminate this information to all interested scouts and their respective parents.
9. Should there be participating/accompanying adults, a Unit Leaders Conference shall be conducted focused on enhancing their proficiency in Compass Reading, Orienteering, and Morse Code. This training aims to equip them with essential skills that can be effectively passed on to their Scouts. To ensure productive learning experience, adult leaders are required to bring a wigwag flag and a compass.
10. In consideration of the activity which is conducted during the uninterrupted period for teachers, accompanying unit leaders/adults shall submit their respective **WAIVER**. They shall be granted with service credits/Compensatory Time Off (CTO)/Compensatory Overtime Credit (COC) in accordance with the existing rules and guidelines.
