

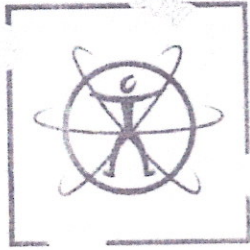

Greetings from the Science Clubbing Movement!

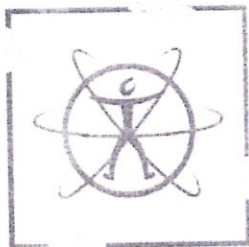

- I. **Pambansang Kapisanan ng mga Kabataan Samahan ng Agham (Philippine Society of Youth Science Clubs or PSYSC), Inc.** is a national organization that promotes the public understanding of science, technology and environment (PUSTE). It supports science and technology education through healthy competitions, lectures, seminars and interactive workshops for students and teachers alike.
- II. To accomplish its objectives, PSYSC is holding the **2025 National Youth Science, Technology, And Environment Summer Camp (NYSTESC)**, an annual four-day event consisting of a lecture series by distinguished experts on a selected field in Science and Technology, interactive workshops for hands-on learning, exposure trips, and other fun-filled activities. This year, the topic for NYSTESC 2025 is **Forensic Science**.
- III. The 2025 NYSTESC celebration aims to:
 - A. Provide a thorough understanding of the concepts and impact of a selected ST&E topic and its multi-disciplinary fields through interaction with experts in the field;
 - B. Promote interest and awareness among the participants on the selected ST&E field and encourage them to acquire further knowledge in such field;
 - C. Encourage the participants to pursue opportunities in the selected ST&E field, in the future;
 - D. Provide a venue for the exchange of ideas and promote camaraderie among elementary science club members nationwide; and
 - E. Encourage more students to join science clubs and to be involved in the science clubbing movement.
- IV. The theme, dates and venue for the 2025 NYSTESC are as follows:

Theme:	CASE 025: Investigating the Veils of Deception
Dates:	July 2025 (official dates to be announced)
Venue:	Luzon (official venue to be announced)

- V. The target participants for the 2025 NYSTESC are junior and senior high school students, advisers, teachers, and coaches from both public and private schools nationwide. Registration for NYSTESC requires science clubs or schools to fill out and submit the necessary forms to the NYSTESC email address: nystesc@psysc.org.
