

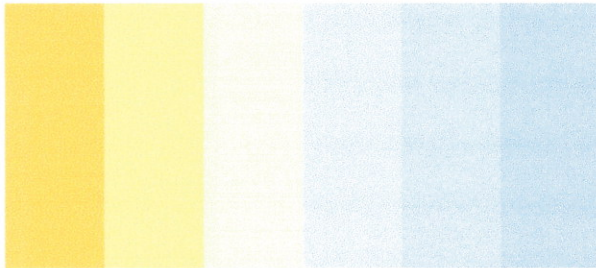

### I. GENERAL OBJECTIVE

The RCY Bohol Summercamp 2025 aims to cultivate dynamic and compassionate youth leaders by strengthening their leadership skills, critical thinking, and sense of responsibility toward their communities. Through a variety of interactive and experiential learning activities, the camp seeks to empower participants to take initiative, lead with empathy, and contribute meaningfully to the betterment of society.

This year's summer camp is dedicated to enhancing youth involvement in community-based programs by deepening their understanding of humanitarian values, disaster preparedness, and environmental sustainability. It also aims to encourage active engagement in volunteer work and foster a strong sense of civic duty among participants.

Furthermore, the camp provides a platform for young individuals to build lasting connections, share innovative ideas, and participate in collaborative efforts through youth-led and youth-serving organizations such as the Red Cross Youth. Ultimately, the RCY Summercamp 2025 endeavors to mold resilient, responsible, and socially aware youth leaders who are ready to serve and make a lasting impact in their communities and beyond.

### J. METHODOLOGY

The camp will feature plenary and interactive sessions led by expert speakers in first aid, disaster risk reduction management, psychological first aid, health promotion during disasters, and environmental conservation.

To effectively assess the participants' learning, personal growth, attitudes, and essential survival skills, a series of outdoor activities and interactive games will be integrated throughout the camp. These activities are carefully designed to encourage teamwork, adaptability, and peer-to-peer engagement. Campers will be **grouped** strategically to foster collaboration and camaraderie among delegates from different councils. A key highlight of the camp is the much-anticipated **Final Challenge: PBB Ultimate Obstacle Relay (Solferino Race)** — a signature Red Cross Youth team-building challenge. This dynamic activity puts

participants' leadership, trust, unity, and cooperation to the test through a series of physically and mentally stimulating tasks. It not only promotes strategic thinking and group synergy but also reinforces the values of resilience, solidarity, and service in action.

Aside from the race, the participants will also be subjected to activities that will test their team spirit, trust in each other, and resilience. The camp will feature **daily challenges, secret challenges, nature hikes, and opportunities for discreet communication.**

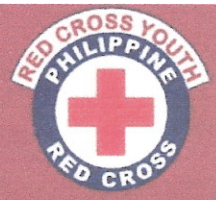
