1. This Office, through the Curriculum and Learning Management Division (CLMD), will conduct a **Training Workshop on Crafting Flexible and Contextualized Alternative Learning System (ALS) Class Program** on June 13-14, 2025, at Applied Nutrition Center, Banilad, Cebu City.

2. This activity aims to:

- increase understanding of the principles, components, and DepEd guidelines in crafting ALS Class Programs;
