1. Relative to the Department of Education's (DepEd) mission to foster holistic learner development, the Bureau of Learner Support Services-School Sports Division (BLSS-SSD) is dedicated to enhancing this agenda through sports and physical activities. To support this, the BLSS-SSD is focused on establishing School Sports Clubs to promote physical fitness, health, and engagement among learners.
2. The BLSS-SSD develops the DepEd Sports Manual, which provides essential guides and instructions for the School Sports Club Program, aiming to improve learners' skills across different sports disciplines.
3. In line with this, the regional office will conduct clusters of Sports Club Facilitators training on Teaching Sports-Specific Skills: one cluster in the Division of Bohol Island and two clusters in the Divisions of Cebu Island under Region VII. DANCESPORTS	Bring dance shoes, if available
SEPAK TAKRAW	Bring Sepak Takraw ball each
TABLE TENNIS	Bring one paddle and one ball
