AN ORDER DECLARING SUSPENSION OF CLASSES ON ALL LEVELS ON JULY 18, 2025 DUE TO INCLEMENT WEATHER

WHEREAS, Tagbilaran City is experiencing inclement weather brought about by weather systems Tropical Depression Crising and the southwest monsoon;

WHEREAS, Heavy Rainfall Warning No. 16, issued by the Visayas PAGASA Regional Service Division at 5 o'clock in morning of July 18, 2025, reported that the entire province of Bohol would experience rains, prompting consideration of suspending classes in Tagbilaran City;

WHEREAS, Heavy Rainfall Warning No. 17, released by Visayas PAGASA Regional Services Division at 8 o'clock in the morning of July 18, 2025 has reported that the entire province of Bohol is already affected by rainfall and that such condition may persist within 2 to 3 hours;

WHEREAS, moderate to heavy rains due to the inclement weather make it unfavorable for students from elementary, high school, and college levels to attend classes;

WHEREAS, the Tagbilaran City Disaster Risk Reduction and Management Office has recommended to the City Mayor the suspension of classes in all levels to prevent students from being adversely affected by the inclement weather on their way to school and back;

WHEREAS, it is the mandate of the City Government of Tagbilaran to ensure the safety of its public and private school students;

NOW, THEREFORE, I, JANE CENSORIA C. YAP, City Mayor, Tagbilaran City, Bohol, by virtue of the powers vested upon me by law, do hereby order the suspension of classes in all levels in public and private schools in the City of Tagbilaran for the entire day of July 18, 2025.
