
SUBJECT : 5TH ADULT LEADERS' EXTRA CHALLENGE

1. Announcing the conduct of the 5TH Adult Leaders' Extra Challenge on August 22-25, 2025 at Caimbang, San Isidro, Bohol.
2. The challenge aims to enhance the scouting skills of our adult leaders as well as improve the activities in the province by engaging them in firsthand experience of adventurous, exciting and learning activities.
3. All currently registered adults (unit leaders, unit committee members, lay leaders and administrators) are eligible to participate.
4. The amount of One Thousand Pesos (P1,000.00) will be collected from each participant to defray the cost of souvenir items and challenge materials. Registration, transportation, and Meals/Snacks on the duration will be the responsibility of each participating team which shall be chargeable to MOOE, SEF, PTA Funds or to any available local/school funds subject to its availability and in accordance with the existing guidelines.
5. Challenge activities/contests will be conducted by teams of 8 members (composed of unit leaders from all sections). Participating adult leaders will be entitled to service credits/compensatory time off (CTO)/Compensatory Overtime Credit (COC) in accordance with the existing guidelines.
6. It is encouraged that participants are holders of a valid Safe from Harm Certificate issued by the World Organization of the Scout Movement (WOSM). You may access the course through this link: <https://learn.scout.org/resource/sfh-1-safe-harm-essential-learnings>
7. Major activities of the challenge will be Kilb-kilab Challenge, Skills Challenge, Community immersion and Campfire.
8. Participating teams are encouraged to exhibit a livelihood/product from their locality during the immersion. Printed procedure of the livelihood/product should be provided to the observers/viewers/spectators. Transportation to and from the immersion site shall be the responsibility of each team.
9. Confirmation through text, call or hard copy must be submitted on or before August 3, 2025 for preparations purposes.
