Further, **classes at all levels are hereby suspended on Monday to Tuesday, 10 to 11 November 2025** in the following regions:


NCR	Region III	Region VI

Region II	Region V	Negros Island Region

This is due to the forecasted major impacts that will be brought about by the Super Typhoon "Uwan".
