**Guidelines and Mechanics of the Contest**

**I. Participants:**

1. The contest is open to all high school students enrolled in either private or public schools in Tagbilaran City Schools Division. The student-contestant may be Catholic or non-Catholic. Any private school, parochial or non-denominational, will be allowed to participate in the contest.
2. The school principal will choose the student-contestant who will represent the school.
3. Each school shall send at two students as contestants.
4. This Bible Quiz Bee will have two stages. The first stage is the district level to be conducted on December 12, this year. The champion in the city level will compete in the diocesan level which will be conducted in January, 2026 as highlight in the National Bible Month celebration.

**II. Nature of Competition:**

1. This quiz bee is an individual contest. Each student-contestant competes with every other student participating in the contest.
2. The student-contestant obtaining the highest score after the three rounds of competition will be declared the champion.
3. The second and third placers may also be recognized.
4. Prizes consisting in cash and certificates will be given to winners in district level.

**III. Coverage:**

1. The quiz bee shall cover general information concerning the following:
  - a. Structure of the Bible – the books composing the Bible both Old and New Testaments.
  - b. Bible Personalities – significant persons mentioned both in Old and New Testaments.
  - c. Narratives and Events – historical and theological stories featured in the Bible.
  - d. Notable Bible Verses – survey of meaningful verses mentioned in both testaments.

**IV. Rounds of Competition:**

1. There are three (3) rounds in the competition, namely:
  - a. Easy – consisting of ten (10) questions with 1 point each.
  - b. Average – consisting of seven (7) questions with 2 points each.
  - c. Difficult – consisting of seven (7) questions with 5 points each.

#### V. Quiz Bee Rules:

1. The students-contestants will be required to wear their respective school uniform during the quiz bee.
2. The students-contestants are expected to arrive at the venue of the contest one hour before the start of the quiz bee.
3. During the conduct of the quiz bee, all contestants will be seated on a stage or elevated platform with enough distances from one another that one cannot read his or her fellow contestant's answer.
4. The contestants are not allowed to carry their cellphone with them during the entire duration of the contest.
5. The quiz bee will be conducted preferably during a school day within the campus of one of the participating schools and, if the school principal approve, it will be witnessed by the rest of the student population.
6. The students-contestants are expected to show utmost honesty during the competition. They must answer the questions independently. Anyone caught cheating will be disqualified from the contest.

#### VI. Quiz Bee Mechanics:

1. Each student-contestant will be assigned with a number written on a sticker paper which will be pasted on his or her shirt.
2. Each student-contestant will be provided with a pentel pen and sufficient number of white long bond paper where his or her answer to the questions will be written.
3. The quiz master will read every question twice. After the second reading, the contestants will be given fifteen (15) seconds to write their answers.
4. When the time is up, the timekeeper will ring the bell or buzzer as signal for the contestants to stop writing and show their answers to the proctors by raising the bond paper.
5. The quiz master will announce the correct answer and the proctors will check the answers of the contestants and record the point or points earned by each contestant in the tally board or tally sheet.
6. After each round, points will be tabulated. The final scores will be tabulated after the difficult round.
7. The answers written in long bond paper will be collected by the proctors from the contestants after every question for checking purposes.
8. After the three rounds of competition, the quiz master and proctors will declare the winners of the quiz bee competition.
