AREA 1 GIRL SCOUTS GOT TALENT 2025

1. In reference to GSP Bohol Council Circular No. 22, s. 2025 titled Provincial Girl Scouts Got Talent 2025, this Office through the School Governance and Operations Division (SGOD) hereby announces the conduct of the **Area 1 Girl Scouts Got Talent 2025** on **January 10, 2026** (Saturday) from 7:30 a.m. to 5:00 p.m. at **Tagbilaran City Central Elementary School and TCCES SNED Center**.

2. Reiterating the contest categories:

3. A medal and certificate will be awarded to the declared First winner, Second Winner and Third Winner. Certificates will also be awarded to the respective winning coaches in all contest categories. Certificates of Participation will also be provided to all contestants and coaches.

4. Teaching and non-teaching participants, including the members of the technical *working committee and judges shall be granted Service Credits/Compensatory Time Off (CTO)*, whichever is applicable, in accordance with the existing rules and regulations.

5. A Registration fee worth **Five Hundred Pesos (P500.00)** shall be collected per participating school to cover the medals for the winners (1st, 2nd & 3rd), certificates, meals and snacks for the board of judges, and other materials needed for the competition on or before **January 06, 2026** at the Division Office.

6. Registration fee, travel expenses and meals of the participants shall be charged to School Maintenance and Other Operating Expenses (MOOE) and/or other available fund source/s subject to the usual accounting and auditing rules and regulations.

Transportation and Food Expenses

Adult Participants or Leaders involved in the District, Area, and Provincial Girl Scouts Got Talent are entitled to either Service Credits or Compensatory Overtime Credits (COC), as applicable.

PROVINCIAL GIRL SCOUTS GOT TALENT 2025

Fiscal Year July 2025 - June 2026

Theme: "Once A Girl Scout, Always A Girl Scout"

GENERAL GUIDELINES

1. Contestants for the Provincial Girl Scouts Got Talent (PGSGT) 2025 must be the officially declared First Prize Winners in their respective categories at the Area Level Girl Scouts Got Talent competition to be eligible for participation.
2. Contestants must not have previously won First Prize in the same category or level in any previous PGSGT event.
3. Contestants must be registered Girl Scouts and shall compete in only one category corresponding to their age level.
4. Contestants must wear the official Girl Scout Dress Uniform, complete with scarf, pins, and cap, for all categories. However, an exception is made for the Folk Dance category, in which participants are required to wear the traditional or prescribed attire appropriate to the dance.
5. District Field Advisers (DFAs) of host districts are required to submit the following documents to the Council after the Area Level competition:
 - A copy of the Area Level Results, including contest category, winner's details, troop information, and registration date.
 - A photocopy of the Troop Registration Form and Official Receipt for all first-place winners.
6. Contestants and District Field Advisers are required to arrive at the venue before the program's official start time. This will allow for registration and the drawing of lots to determine the order of performance. For specific schedule, refer to Council Circular No. 22, S.2025.
7. Contestants are required to attend the Opening Program of the competition at the venue, where they will be officially recognized.
8. Contestants must strictly comply with both the General Guidelines and the Contest-Specific Guidelines.
9. The decision of the Board of Judges shall be final and binding, and shall not be subject to appeal.
