**2026 DIVISION BIBLE QUIZ BEE**

1. In relation to the observance of the 2026 Bible Month Celebration, the Division Office through Curriculum Implementation Division will conduct a Division Bible Quiz Bee on **January 28, 2026**, from 1:00 pm to 5:00 pm at **Cogon Elementary School Audio Visual Hall**.
2. Relative to this, the schools are enjoined to conduct their school level bible quiz to determine their school representatives.
3. School Heads are advised to make necessary arrangement in adherence to DepEd Order 9, s. 2005, "Instituting Measures To Increased Time-on Task and Ensuring Compliance Therewith" It is also reiterated that activities related to the celebration shall not entail financial burdens to the learners and parents.
4. Quiz Masters, Scorekeepers, Medal/Certificate in charge and Physical Arrangement in charge are requested to be at the venue by 10:00 am for the briefing and preparation of their respective functions.
5. Snacks and transportation of the participants shall be chargeable against the school MOOE or other school funds available.

## **MECHANICS/ RULES OF THE 2025 BIBLE QUIZ**

1. There shall be three (3) participants per team coming from Elementary and High School.
2. The team will complete the Easy, Average and Difficult round, with ten (10) questions per category with corresponding one (1) point per question.
3. Each of the questions shall be read twice by the quiz master. After the second reading, the quiz master will say "Go" and the team will be given a specific time limit to write their answer Easy Questions (10 seconds) , Average ( 15 seconds) and Difficult (25 seconds).
4. After the given time, the timekeeper will ring the bell or buzzer, and the team will show their answer by raising their board/card for the proctors to check and for the tally board and sheet score keeper to record scores.
5. Scores will be tabulated after each round and final scores will be tabulated after the difficult round.
6. In the case of a tie, 3 clincher questions will be asked. The team with the highest score will be declared as Champion.
7. In the event that there will be complaints arise during the given round, complaint should be raised right away before the next question will be asked. Only the registered coach is allowed to raise the complaint to the team of arbiters.
8. The decision of the board of judges shall be final and irrevocable.

## **CODE OF CONDUCT**

### ***For the PARTICIPANTS***

1. Participants should wear their school uniform/ prescribed uniform.
2. Arrive on time and be present at the venue when required.
3. Abide by all the rules and regulations of the Quiz Bee.
4. Do not cheat, use unauthorized materials, or seek help from others during the quiz.
5. Always show courtesy and sportsmanship towards fellow participants.
6. Avoid loud or disruptive behavior that could interfere with the smooth running of the event.
7. Refrain from using mobile phones or any other electronic devices unless permitted by the event organizers.
8. In the case of disagreements or concerns, raise the issue politely with the quizmaster or organizer. Do not argue loudly or disrupt the quiz.

### ***For the ORGANIZERS AND OFFICIALS***

1. Ensure all participants are treated fairly and equally, without favoritism.
2. Address complaints or concerns fairly, following the event's rules and procedures.
3. Communicate decisions and clarifications about rules or scoring promptly and transparently.

### ***For Spectators/ Audience***

1. Keep quiet during the quiz to allow participants to concentrate and hear the questions clearly.
2. Do not interfere with the quiz process in any way, including by interrupting or distracting the organizers, quizmaster, or participants.
3. Cheer for all participants in a positive, respectful manner.
