**UPLOADING OF THE WASH IN SCHOOLS (WinS) DATA FOR SY 2025-2026 THROUGH
THE ENHANCED ONLINE MONITORING SYSTEM (E-OMS)**

To: Assistant Schools Division Superintendent
Public Elementary and Secondary School heads
Division and School WinS Coordinators
All Others Concerned

1. In line with the implementation of the Water, Sanitation and Hygiene in Schools (WinS) Program and to ensure accurate and timely monitoring of program indicators, all public elementary and secondary schools are hereby directed to upload their WinS data for School Year (S.Y.) 2025–2026 through the Enhanced Online Monitoring System (e-OMS).
2. The official period for data uploading shall commence on January 26, 2026 and shall continue until March 31, 2026.
3. All concerned are reminded to download and use only the latest version of the WinS monitoring form from the e-OMS. This updated version already includes the School-Based Feeding Program (SBFP) indicator, specifically requiring the number of beneficiaries disaggregated by sex (male and female).
4. School Heads and WinS Coordinators are enjoined to ensure the accuracy, completeness, and timeliness of the data to be uploaded through the e-OMS.
5. Immediate and strict compliance with this memorandum is hereby enjoined.

This Office officially announces the opening of the **National Uploading and Validation of the WASH in Schools (WinS) Program for SY 2025-2026**. The uploading will commence on **January 26, 2026** and continue until **March 31, 2026** in reference to DepEd Order No. 10, s. 2016 or the "Policy and Guidelines for the Comprehensive Water, Sanitation, and Hygiene in (WASH) in Schools (WinS) Program which established quality standards for water, sanitation, deworming and health education. The Three-Star Approach (TSA) is used by the WinS Program as an integrated system for monitoring, performance recognition and quality assurance guided by DepEd Memorandum No. 194, s. 2018.

Please be advised of the following:

1. Ensure that the downloaded monitoring forms are the latest version which includes the SBFP indicator requesting the number of beneficiaries disaggregated by sex.
2. In the event of a discrepancy between the result of the offline monitoring form and the uploaded monitoring at the e-OMS, the result on the uploaded report in the e-OMS shall be the official star rating. The star rating indicated on the uploaded form shall prevail.
3. For non-DepEd elementary and secondary schools, please upload a blank form only.
4. In the event of an uploading interruption, the issue will be coordinated directly with ICTS-SID. In case the ICTS-SID advises that system maintenance is required, Regional WinS Coordinators will be notified accordingly.

To be guided properly, all ROs and SDOs WinS Coordinators are highly encouraged to revisit DepEd Order No. 10, s. 2016 and DepEd Memorandum No. 194, s. 2018.
