SUBJECT : **COUNCIL ADVANCEMENT AND SURVIVAL CAMPS FOR SENIOR SCOUTS**

1. We are pleased to announce the conduct of the Council Advancement and Survival Camps for Senior Scouts on February 7-8, 2026 at Roxas Park Elementary School, Calma, Garcia-Hernandez, Bohol.
2. This is to give opportunity for aspiring scouts to comply the requirements in the BSP Advancement Ladder, enhance useful life skills, learn important values and develop their leadership skills.
3. Qualified to participate are those physically fit as certified by a physician duly registered Senior Scouts from 12 - 17 years old with a parent's consent.
4. A registration of One Thousand Pesos (P 1,000.00) will be charge to each participant for the cost of meals/snacks and administrative expenses. Registration, Transportation and other incidental expenses can be charge to the MOOE, SEF or any other available local school funds subject to its availability and the usual accounting and auditing procedures.
5. Attending Outfit Advisors as chaperons shall also pay the registration fee and shall be utilized as support staff and are entitled to service credits/Compensatory Overtime Credit (COC) in accordance with the existing rules and guidelines.
6. The Survival Camp will serve as a Council Board of Review. Thus, only those who have their respective passports and all other required documents will be accepted.
7. All participants shall report at the venue in Type A uniform at 8:00 o'clock in the morning of February 7, 2026 for registration, camp set up and opening program bringing the following:
 - Type A & B uniforms
 - camping (personal tents) and sleeping gears
 - first aid kit
 - swimming trunk/shorts
 - long pants
 - extra shirts and underwear
 - flashlights and compass
 - rubber shoes and slippers
 - ballpen and notebook
 - mess kit and toiletries
 - Raincoat/Ponzo
