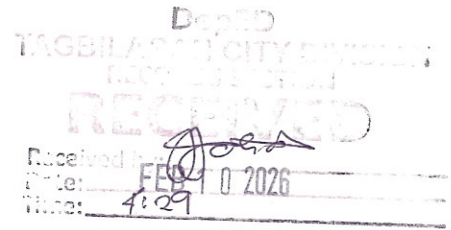

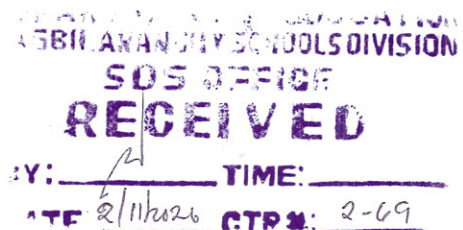

The discussion will focus on the following topics:

1. Large-scale mining operations vs. Indigenous Peoples’ ancestral land rights in the Philippines
2. Impact of rice importation policies on the livelihood and income of Filipino rice farmers
3. Ineffective solid waste management in tourist and coastal areas of the Philippines
4. Coral reef degradation in Bohol seas due to tourism pressure and illegal fishing
5. Limited access to affordable mental health services for Filipino students
6. Online privacy risks and data misuse among Filipino internet users
7. Rising lifestyle-related diseases among Filipinos due to poor diet and sedentary living

If attending, kindly complete the Registration Form by **February 14, 2026**. Furthermore, the format of the parental consent form will be provided, and participating schools shall be responsible for printing and completing the said document.
