**Qualifications of Campers**

- Girls
- Must be registered Junior, Senior, or Cadet Girl Scout as of March 31, 2026
  - Must be physically fit and in good health as certified by a licensed physician
  - Must have earned at least one (1) badge under the Eight-Point Challenge, and
  - Must have previously participated in a troop, school, and district camp
- Adults
- Must be a registered Troop Leader as of March 31, 2026
  - Must be physically fit to withstand the rigors of outdoor life and camping activities
  - Must know and understand her girls under her supervision
  - Must have knowledge of basic First Aid
  - Must have completed the Basic Course and the Outdoor Leadership Course
  - Must have previously participated in a troop, school, and district camp

Participants must be screened and provided with the required pre-camp training to be conducted during Girl Scouting time in school.

**Camp Fee and Inclusions**

One Thousand Pesos (P1,000.00) per camper to cover for program materials, event t-shirt, event bag, event button pin, event scarf (for adults), ribbon for scarf (for girls), Eight-Point Challenge badges, and Certificate of Participation.

The camp fee, transportation, and incidental expenses of the campers/contingent may be charged to the Division/School Maintenance and Other Operating Expenses (MOOE), Special Education Fund (SEF), District share of SMFC tickets, and local and other sources of fund subject to the usual accounting and auditing rules and regulations.

**Confirmation and Pre-Registration of Campers**

Confirmation and pre-registration of campers must be completed **on or before February 23, 2026**. Slots allotted to districts that fail to confirm by the deadline shall be automatically reallocated to the host district and other interested districts.

**Required Forms**

Enclosed are the Reply Slip, Application Form, Parent's Consent, and Health Examination Form which must be duly accomplished and submitted upon pre-registration on or before the prescribed deadline.

**Arrival, Settling Down, Completion**

Campers/contingents are expected to arrive at the campsite starting 3:00 p.m. on March 5 (Thursday) until not later than 7:00 a.m. on March 6 (Friday). All participants must arrive fully equipped, with packed meals (dinner and/or breakfast) and all items necessary for the duration of the camp.

The Parade on March 6 shall commence at 8:30 a.m. immediately followed by the Opening Ceremony.

Campers will only be awarded with badges and certificates upon successful completion of the whole duration of the camp.

- Two (2) sets of GSP Camp Uniform with green socks
- GSP Business Uniform with Adult pins and scarf
- GSP Alternate Uniform - white blouse, green pants & green vest
- GSP Black/Green Adult Polo Shirt
- Physical Fitness outfit: jogging pants and sweat shirt
- Sleeping garments (preferably pajamas)
- Comfortable working clothes
- Several changes of underwear
- Casual Dress
- Face and bath towels
- Outdoor beddings: oil cloth & blanket
- Bedroll/Sleeping bag
- Water canteen/Tumbler
- Set of eating utensils (plastic plate, spoon, fork, Cup and saucer, tumbler, knife, cloth napkin, all these placed in a drawstring bag)
- Wide-brim hat for Adult/Troop Leaders
- Scout Knife, Can Opener
- Sit-upon (a plastic sheet about 3ft. square)
- Raincoat
- Writing and art materials
- Flashlight, Sewing kit
- Toilet Articles (soap, toothbrush, toothpaste etc.)

## Service Credit/Compensatory Overtime Credit (COC)


