


COUNCIL MEMORANDUM

SUBJECT : **COUNCIL SCOUT YOUTH FORUM**

1. Announcing the conduct of the Council Scout Youth Forum on March 6-8, 2026 at Roxas Park Elementary School, Calma, Garcia-Hernandez, Bohol.
2. The forum aims to:
 - i. Orient our scouts in parliamentary procedures as young leaders in our communities.
 - ii. Provide them an opportunity to express their ideas on the current issues of the country.
 - iii. Elect scout representatives to the Council Executive Board and to the National Scout Youth Forum for the year 2026.
3. Each district is encouraged to send their two (2) most qualified duly registered Senior Scouts of ages 12-17 years old with good scholastic record and can speak English and Filipino fluently.
4. A registration fee of One Thousand Five Hundred Pesos (P 1,500.00) per participant will be collected for the cost of meals/snacks (from Lunch on March 6 until lunch of March 8, 2026), forum materials and documentation expenses. Registration, transportation and other incidental expenses of participants can be charge to the MOOE, SEF, School/District Scouting Funds or to any other available local school funds subject to its availability and in accordance with the existing auditing and accounting guidelines.
5. Attending Outfit Advisors as chaperons shall also pay the registration fee and shall be utilized as support staff and are entitled to service credits/Compensatory Overtime Credit (COC) in accordance with the existing rules and guidelines.
6. All participants must report at the venue in scout uniform at 8:00 o'clock on the first day of the above-mentioned schedule for the opening program, groupings and orientation.
