



QUARTER 1 PROGRAM IMPLEMENTATION REVIEW IN ALTERNATIVE LEARNING SYSTEM (ALS)

1. This Office, through the Curriculum and Learning Management Division (CLMD), shall conduct the **Quarter 1 Program Implementation Review (PIR) for the Alternative Learning System (ALS)** on April 16-17, 2026, at the Applied Nutrition Center, Banilad, Cebu City.


2. This activity aims to:

- a. Review and assess the implementation of ALS programs, projects, and activities (PPAs) for the first quarter and analyze their strengths and weaknesses to facilitate timely adjustments and continuous improvement toward achieving effective outcomes;
- b. present consolidated ALS data reports on the following:
 - 2025 PSF Utilization Report;
 - Tracking of ALS Teachers' Career Advancement under the DepEd Education Career Progression System (ECPS);
 - Assessment of Basic Literacy Test (BLT) Scores (2020-2021 to SY 2024-2025);
 - Tracking of ALS Learners (SY 2020-2021 to SY 2023-2024);
 - Accreditation and Equivalency (A&E) Test Registration and Administration; and
 - Division End-of-School Year (EOSY Accomplishments, Concerns, Issues, Gaps, and Problems /(CIGPs), and Recommendations.
- c. share best practices and innovations in the implementation of the ALS program categorized by Key Result Area (KRA).

3. The participants in this activity include the CLMD Chief, Regional and Division ALS Focal Persons, and select Education Program Specialists II for ALS from the 12 Schools Division Offices (SDOs).
