**ONE-DAY ORIENTATION-WORKSHOP ON THE STRENGTHENED SENIOR HIGH
SCHOOL CURRICULUM**

To: Assistant Schools Division Superintendent
Chief Education Supervisors
Education Program Supervisors
Public and Private Senior High School Heads/Principals

1. In line with the Department of Education's continuing efforts to enhance the quality and responsiveness of basic education, the Strengthened Senior High School (SHS) Curriculum shall be fully implemented in School Year 2026–2027. This reform introduces key improvements in curriculum structure, learning competencies, and program delivery aligned with higher education standards and industry demands. To ensure readiness and alignment among schools, this Division will conduct a One-Day Orientation-Workshop aimed at equipping school leaders and coordinators with essential knowledge on the curriculum's features and implementation guidelines on April 21, 2026 at Panda Tea Hotel, JA Clarin Street, Tagbilaran City.
3. This activity is a one-day orientation-workshop designed to provide school leaders and key personnel with essential information on the Strengthened Senior High School Curriculum, including its key features, implementation guidelines, and required school-level preparations. It aims to ensure that all senior high schools in the division are adequately informed and aligned for its effective implementation.
4. This activity aims to:
 - a. provide participants with a clear understanding of the policy directions and key features of the Strengthened SHS Curriculum;
 - b. explain the structural adjustments and implementation guidelines of the strengthened curriculum;
 - c. clarify the roles and responsibilities of school heads and coordinators in curriculum implementation; and
 - d. formulate initial school-level preparations and strategies for School Year 2026–2027 implementation.
5. The participants to this activity are: a. Chiefs: CID & SGOD, b. EPSvrs I, c. Public and Private Senior High School Heads/Principals, d. Academic Track Coordinators, e. Tech-Pro Coordinators.
6. A registration fee of Ph700.00 shall be collected to all participants (public and private) to cover meals (2 snacks & lunch) chargeable against School MOOE subject to usual accounting and auditing rules and regulations for public school participants. While the Division personnel fee is chargeable to Division MOOE/HRTD funds.
7. Immediate dissemination of and strict compliance with this Memorandum are desired.
