4. All student-participants are required to secure medical certificates and parental consent to be submitted to the 2026 NSPC registration committee chair or any other representative on Day 0 of the activity.
5. Relative to this, teachers attending the activity shall be granted service credits while Compensatory Time-Off (CTO) for the non-teaching pursuant to the guidelines specified in DepEd Order No. 53, s. 2003 (Updated Guidelines on the Grant of Vacation Service Credits of Teachers) and per CSC-DBM Joint Circular No. 2, s. 2004 (Non-Monetary Remuneration for Overtime Services), whichever is appropriate and applicable.
6. Incidental expenses incurred by the official delegates shall be covered by the school's MOOE/local funds/regional funds/Special Education Fund, or the Camus Journalism Fund, and other applicable sources. However, the travel expenses of student participants will be subsidized by the Central Office through funds downloaded to the Schools Division Offices (SDOs) for the purpose, subject to the usual accounting and auditing rules and regulations.
