**CONDUCT OF VIRTUAL ORIENTATION FOR THE ARAL SUMMER PROGRAM**

To: Chiefs, CID, and SGOD  
Heads of Public Elementary and Secondary Schools

1. Per Memorandum DM-OULS-2026-154, a **Virtual Orientation for the ARAL Summer Program** will be conducted by the National Educators Academy of the Philippines (NEAP) on **May 4, 2026, from 9:00 AM to 10:30 AM** via the **DepEd Philippines Facebook Page**.
2. The activity aims to provide orientation on the key features, implementation guidelines, and operational processes of the ARAL Summer Program to ensure alignment and readiness among field implementers.
3. Participants are expected to gain a clear understanding of their roles and responsibilities as well as the program's delivery mechanisms and support systems, to ensure effective and standardized implementation across regions and divisions.
4. The orientation will cover the following components:
  - a. Rationale of ARAL Summer
  - b. Policy Statement of ARAL Summer
  - c. DepEd Summer Programs
  - d. Participation of Learners in the Summer Programs
  - e. Program Implementation
  - f. Structure of Summer Remediation Program Sessions
  - g. Program Support
  - h. Incentives Summer Remediation Program Teachers
5. School Heads shall ensure that all summer ARAL tutors attend the virtual orientation. School Heads shall appoint an area in their respective schools where all the participants can gather for the online activity. They ensure a stable internet connection and availability throughout the orientation. They are likewise encouraged to log in at least 10 to 15 minutes before the start of the session to avoid technical delays and ensure smooth access to the live broadcast.
6. **School consultants** are enjoined to help disseminate information to the field and ensure that all identified participants are able to join the activity. Likewise, they are expected to monitor the schools under their supervision and provide the necessary technical assistance as needed.
7. Travel expenses incurred during the conduct of this activity shall be charged against School MOOE, subject to existing accounting and auditing rules and regulations.
8. Immediate dissemination and compliance with this Memorandum are desired.
