2. This activity aims to:
- develop instructional plans (iPlans) for both A&E Elementary and Junior High School levels;
 - evaluate the developed iPlans against established DepEd quality standards and curriculum competencies; and
 - quality assure and enhance the iPlans to ensure they effectively address the diverse learning needs of Out-of-School Youth and Adults (OSYAs).
3. Teaching and non-teaching personnel who will attend the two activities scheduled on July 1, 2026, coinciding with the Charter Day of Tagbilaran City, a declared non-working holiday, and those extending until Saturday shall be granted the appropriate benefit for services rendered beyond regular working days. Teaching personnel shall be entitled to Vacation Service Credits in accordance with DepEd Order No. 53, s. 2003 (Updated Guidelines on Grant of Vacation Service Credits to Teachers), while non-teaching personnel shall be granted Compensatory Time-Off (CTO) pursuant to CSC-DBM Joint Circular No. 2, s. 2004 (Non-Monetary Remuneration for Overtime Services Rendered), whichever is applicable.

Teacher-participants shall utilize modular learning modality to ensure that classroom instruction remains uninterrupted during the conduct of the activities. 4. Teaching and non-teaching personnel attending the Workshop on the Evaluation and QA that ends on Saturday shall be granted Service Credits pursuant to the guidelines



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


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specified in DepEd Order no. 53, s. 2003 (Updated Guidelines on Grant of Vacation Service Credits to Teachers) or Compensatory Time-Off (CTO) per CSC-DBM Joint Circular No. 2, s. 2004 (Non-Monetary Remuneration for Overtime Services Rendered), whichever is appropriate and applicable.

5. Expenses for board and lodging, meals, and supplies and materials shall be charged against the Fiscal Year (FY) 2025 ALS Program Support Fund (PSF), while travel and other incidental expenses of the participants shall be charged against their respective Division ALS PSF, local funds or MOOE, subject to the usual accounting and auditing rules and regulations.
