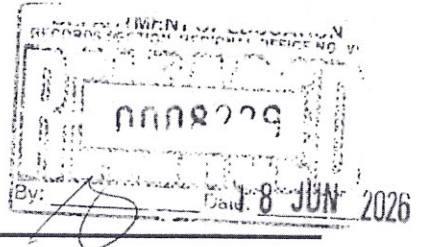

COMPETENCY MAPPING AND ALIGNMENT OF PROJECT DULA AND PROJECT BRIDGE WITH THREE-TERM BUDGET OF WORK

To: Schools Division Superintendents
 Assistant Schools Division Superintendents
 All Others Concerned

1. In line with the Department's commitment to strengthen literacy and foundational learning interventions, this Office announces the conduct of the *Competency Mapping and Alignment of Project DULA and Project BRIDGE with the Three-Term Budget of Work* on **July 13-17, 2026**, at the **Applied Nutrition Center, Banilad, Cebu City**.
2. **The Project DULA** (Developing and Unleashing Learners' Abilities through Play) and **Project BRIDGE** (Building Resources for Inclusive Development, Growth, and Education) are flagship regional innovations for Special Needs Education, Multigrade, and Kindergarten that provide inclusive instructional materials. Both projects are intentionally designed to promote inclusivity in classrooms, ensuring that learners of diverse backgrounds, abilities, and learning needs are supported through play-based, learner-centered, and differentiated approaches.
3. The activity aims to:
 - a. review existing competencies, learning standards, and instructional content of Project DULA and Project BRIDGE as inclusive classroom materials;
 - b. map and sequence competencies across grade levels and learning areas, ensuring progression that supports diverse learners;
 - c. align identified competencies with the requirements of the Three-Term School Calendar;
 - d. develop a harmonized Three-Term Budget of Work for both projects that integrates inclusivity principles; and
 - e. establish implementation guidelines to ensure consistency, inclusivity, and coherence in delivery across divisions and schools.
4. The output of the activity shall be the following:
 - a. competency maps for Project DULA and Project Bridge, highlighting inclusive learning pathways;
 - b. aligned three-term budget for each project;
 - c. recommended learning progression and competency distribution per term that addresses learner diversity; and
 - d. implementation of recommendations for regional adoption and monitoring with emphasis on inclusive practices.



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5. The participants are the following:
 - a. Schools Division Supervisors in Kindergarten and Special Needs Education;
 - b. Public School District Supervisors who possess knowledge or have been involved in the development and implementation of Project DULA and Project BRIDGE; and
 - c. School Heads who have actively participated in the conceptualization, development, validation, and implementation of the projects.
6. The Schools Division Offices shall identify and endorse participants who can substantially contribute to the review, mapping, and alignment processes based on their expertise and involvement.
7. Participants are expected to bring relevant curriculum guides, project documents, competency matrices, and other reference materials necessary for the successful completion of the activity outputs.
8. The first meal will be lunch on July 13, 2026, and the last meal will be dinner on July 17, 2026. Registration will start at 10:00 am on July 13, 2026.
9. Expenses for food, board and lodging, supplies, and other incidental expenses shall be charged against available SPED Funds, subject to the usual accounting, auditing, budgeting, and procurement rules and regulations.
10. Immediate dissemination of and strict compliance with this Memorandum are enjoined.
