**DIVISION SEMINAR-WORKSHOP ON THE IMPLEMENTATION OF THE REVISED
K TO 10 TECHNOLOGY AND LIVELIHOOD EDUCATION (TLE) CURRICULUM FOR
GRADE 9 AND GRADE 10 TLE TEACHERS**

1. In line with the Department of Education's continuing implementation of the Revised K to 10 Curriculum and its commitment to strengthening teachers' instructional competence, the Schools Division Office of Tagbilaran City shall conduct the **Division Seminar-Workshop on the Implementation of the Revised K to 10 Technology and Livelihood Education (TLE) Curriculum for Grade 9 and Grade 10 Teachers on August 15 and 22, 2026 (Saturdays) at Panda Tea Garden Suites, J.A. Clarin Street, Tagbilaran City.**

2. The activity aims to strengthen the capacity of Grade 9 and Grade 10 TLE teachers in implementing the revised curriculum through curriculum guide analysis and competency unpacking, preparation of the Budget of Work (BOW), application of learner-centered teaching pedagogies and strategies, development of competency-based and authentic assessment tools, preparation of contextualized Learning Activity Sheets (LAS), and crafting of Daily Lesson Logs (DLL) using the ILAW Framework. It likewise seeks to produce quality-assured instructional resources that shall serve as common references in the delivery of Technology and Livelihood Education across the division. Specifically, the seminar-workshop seeks to:

- a. deepen teachers' understanding of the Revised K to 10 TLE Curriculum;
- b. unpack curriculum competencies into measurable learning targets;
- c. prepare the Budget of Work aligned with the revised curriculum;
- d. strengthen teachers' competence in applying effective, learner-centered teaching pedagogies and instructional strategies;
- e. develop competency-based and authentic classroom assessment tools;
- f. prepare contextualized Learning Activity Sheets (LAS);
- g. develop ILAW-based Daily Lesson Logs (DLL); and

h. produce quality-assured instructional materials ready for classroom implementation.

4. The workshop outputs shall include:

- Unpacked Curriculum Guides;
- Budget of Work (BOW);
- Teaching Pedagogy and Strategy Matrix;
- Competency-Based Assessment Tools;
- Learning Activity Sheets (LAS); and
- ILAW-Based Daily Lesson Logs (DLL).

7. Since the activity shall be conducted on **two (2) Saturdays**, participating **teaching personnel** shall be entitled to **service credit**, subject to existing DepEd rules and regulations on the grant of service credit. Likewise, eligible **non-teaching personnel** who render services during the activity shall be granted **Compensatory Time Off (CTO)** in accordance with existing Civil Service Commission, Department of Budget and Management, and DepEd issuances.

8. Enclosed is the list of participants by school.

9. Expenses relative to meals, venue, and other allowable expenses shall be **charged against the FY 2026 DepEd Downloaded Basic Education Curriculum (BEC) Funds**, subject to the usual government accounting, auditing, budgeting, and procurement rules and regulations.

10. School Heads are enjoined to ensure the attendance and active participation of their concerned teachers to guarantee the successful implementation of the revised curriculum and the quality of TLE instruction in their respective schools.

11. Immediate dissemination of and compliance with this Memorandum are desired.
