**ROBOTICS TRAINING ENHANCEMENT COURSE AND

1. This Office, through the Curriculum and Implementation Division (CID) hereby announces the conduct of **Robotics Training Enhancement Course and Skills Development for Teachers on July 18 and 25, 2026 at BODARE, Multipurpose Building Tagbilaran City, Bohol.**

2. The primary objectives of this activity are:

- 2.1 *Enhance teachers' knowledge and understanding of educational robotics by providing hands-on training on robot design, programming, sensor integration, and the application of robotics in classroom instruction.*
- 2.2 *Develop teachers' technical skills in robotics through practical activities that strengthen their ability to build, program, troubleshoot, and operate robotics systems aligned with current educational standards and competition requirements.*
- 2.3 *Equip teachers with effective strategies and best practices for coaching learners in robotics by familiarizing them with competition guidelines, problem-solving approaches, and innovative instructional methods that promote STEM learning and prepare students for robotics competitions such as the World Robot Olympiad (WRO) and the National Robotics Competition (NRC).*

A **Registration Fee of Seven Hundred Fifty Pesos (Php 750.00) per day per participant, with a total of One Thousand Five Hundred Pesos (Php 1,500.00) for two (2) days** will be collected from each participant to cover meals, snacks, supplies and other incidental expenses relative to the conduct of the activity and shall be charged against Division HRTD Fund (for SDO participants and facilitators) and School Funds/MOOE (for participants from the schools). Expenses relative to the conduct of the activity are subject to the usual accounting and auditing rules and regulations. Payments can be made in cash and cheque to the DepEd Division of Tagbilaran City. Participants from schools are highly encouraged to pay the registration fee starting **July 8, 2026, or during the conduct of the training.**
5. Participants are required to bring the following: Robotics Kit, Laptop, extension wire, and other materials needed for the conduct of the training.
6. Teacher participants in this activity shall be entitled to service credits in accordance with the provisions of DO No. 013, s.2024 (Revised Guidelines on the Grant of Vacation Service Credits for Teachers and DO No. 53, s.2003 (for participation in activity during weekends and holidays or vacations). On the other hand, non-teaching personnel shall be provided with Compensatory Time Off (CTO) per CSC DBM Joint Circular No. 2s,2004.
