**EPP/TLE RETOOLING OF TEACHERS ON THE IMPLEMENTATION OF THE
REVISED K TO 10 CURRICULUM**

1. In line with the implementation of the Revised K to 10 Curriculum and the continuing professional development of teachers, the Schools Division Office of Tagbilaran City, through the Curriculum Implementation Division (CID), shall conduct the **EPP/TLE Retooling of Teachers on July 25 and August 1, 2026 (Saturdays)** at **City Central Elementary School, Tagbilaran City**. The activity aims to strengthen teachers' pedagogical content knowledge, enhance technical competencies, and equip them with relevant industry-based skills necessary for the effective delivery of the revised EPP/TLE curriculum. Specifically, the activity aims to:

- a. strengthen teachers' competence in integrating Information and Communications Technology (ICT) in teaching and learning;
- b. deepen teachers' understanding of the revised learning competencies, performance standards, and assessment strategies in EPP/TLE;
- c. enhance teachers' technical knowledge and practical skills in Agriculture, Animal Production, Fisheries, and Home Economics aligned with their grade level specialization;
- d. develop contextualized learning resources and assessment (ILAW Based DLL & PISA Approached) and classroom activities that promote higher-order thinking skills and authentic performance tasks; and
- e. prepare teachers for the effective implementation of the revised EPP/TLE curriculum for School Year 2026–2027.

2. Enclosed is the list of participant(s) per school.

3. Expenses relative to the conduct of this activity, including training materials, meals, snacks, and other authorized expenses, shall be **charged against the downloaded FY 2026 Basic Education Curriculum (BEC) Funds**, subject to the usual accounting and auditing rules and regulations.

4. Travel expenses of participants shall be charged against school/ local funds, subject to the availability of funds and existing government accounting and auditing rules.
5. Since the activity shall be conducted on **Saturdays**, participating teachers shall be entitled to **Vacation Service Credits**, while qualified non-teaching personnel who render services during the activity shall be granted **Compensatory Time-Off (CTO)** in accordance with existing DepEd and Civil Service Commission policies.
6. School Heads are requested to:
 - ensure the attendance of all identified participants;
 - facilitate the dissemination of this Memorandum;
 - provide appropriate administrative support to participants before and after the training; and
 - monitor the application of the learning gained during classroom implementation.
7. Immediate and widest dissemination of this Memorandum is desired.
