Details of the activity are as follows:

Orientation 1	Orientation on the Chief Girl Scout Medal Scheme (CGSMS)
Participants	1. Registered Senior or Cadet Girl Scout 2. Registered Troop Leader of the Senior or Cadet Girl Scout The Senior or Cadet Girl Scout and her Troop Leader must attend the orientation together. Neither the Girl Scout nor the Troop Leader shall be allowed to attend the orientation alone.
Qualifications	• Girl and Troop Leader must be registered at the time of application • Girl must have at least three years of Girl Scouting experience as a Star/Junior/Senior • Girl must have participated in a 3-day troop camp; and District Camp/ Council Camp/Regional Camp/National Camp A girl who has not yet participated in a Regional Camp at the time of application may be accepted, provided that she participates in the Regional Camp within the fiscal year period. She shall also be given priority for a slot in the National Camp.

	The PHL Troop Achievement Award and Magic Spot Projects are community development projects to be undertaken by the troop.
Participants	1. At least 3 registered Junior, Senior or Cadet Girl Scouts from the troop 2. Registered Troop Leader of the Junior, Senior or Cadet Girl Scouts The Junior, Senior or Cadet Girl Scouts and their Troop Leader must attend the orientation together. Neither the Girl Scouts nor the Troop Leader shall be allowed to attend the orientation alone.
Qualifications	• Girls and Troop Leader must be registered at the time of application • Troop must be registered for at least three (3) consecutive years • Each girl in the troop must have earned at least five (5) badges on the 8-Point Challenge Program
National Award and Recognition	Certificate of Recognition and Cash Prize

Registration Fee

A minimal registration fee of Two Hundred Fifty Pesos (P 250.00) per participant shall be collected to cover the cost of lunch and AM/PM snacks. The Council shall shoulder the expenses for the meeting materials.

The registration fee and transportation expenses of the participants may be charged to the Maintenance and Other Operating Expenses (MOOE), Special Education Fund (SEF), or any other available source of funds, subject to the approval of DepEd Bohol and DepEd Tagbilaran City Divisions, and in accordance with the usual accounting and auditing rules and regulations.

GSP Attire

Girl: Dress Uniform with scarf and close black shoes

Adult: Alternate Uniform (white blouse, green pants and vest) and close black shoes

Service Credit/Compensatory Overtime Credit

Troop Leaders shall be entitled to either Service Credit or Compensatory Overtime Credit (COC) whichever is applicable, in accordance with DepEd Guidelines.
