**DISSEMINATION OF INFORMATION ON THE MARITIME ACADEMY OF ASIA
AND THE PACIFIC (MAAP) SCHOLARSHIP PROGRAM AND CLASS OF 2031
ENTRANCE EXAMINATION**

1. Pursuant to the request of the Maritime Academy of Asia and the Pacific (MAAP), this Office disseminates information regarding the MAAP Scholarship Program and the Class of 2031 MAAP Entrance Examination to all public secondary schools for appropriate information and widest dissemination to eligible learners.

The MAAP Scholarship Program provides deserving Filipino youth the opportunity to pursue quality maritime education through a comprehensive scholarship that includes tuition, board and lodging, shipboard training, modern training facilities, and employment opportunities aboard international shipping companies. Applicants who qualify shall undergo the MAAP Entrance Examination, Personal Interview, Medical and Physical Examinations, and the Indoctrination Orientation Period (RAMP).

2. The MAAP Entrance Examination for applicants from the Province of Bohol is scheduled on:

Date: October 17, 2026 (Saturday)

Time: 6:00 A.M.

Venue: Dr. Cecilio Putong National High School, Tagbilaran City

A Scholarship Information Drive shall likewise be conducted in conjunction with the entrance examination.

Eligible applicants must satisfy the qualifications prescribed by MAAP, including but not limited to being a natural-born Filipino, physically fit, of good moral character, meeting the required age and academic qualifications, and obtaining a General Point Average (GPA) of at least 83%. Interested applicants are encouraged to prepare the documentary requirements and comply with the admission procedures prescribed by MAAP.

4. Accordingly, all Public Secondary School Heads are requested to:

- Disseminate this information to all Grade 12 learners and other qualified graduates who may be interested in pursuing maritime education;
- Post the attached advisory on school bulletin boards and official communication platforms;
- Encourage qualified learners to participate in the Scholarship Information Drive and MAAP Entrance Examination; and
- Extend appropriate assistance in informing prospective applicants regarding the scholarship opportunity.

5. Participation in the scholarship examination and information drive shall be voluntary and shall not disrupt regular class schedules or official school activities.
