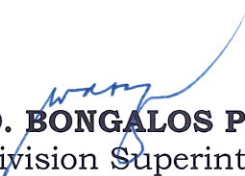

**FOLLOW-UP MONITORING AND INITIAL JUDGING FOR THE DIVISION SEARCH
ON CONTAINERIZED UBE PLANTING IN SCHOOLS AS AN AGRICULTURAL
LEARNING OUTPUT**

To: Assistant Schools Division Superintendent
Chiefs of Divisions
Public Elementary and Secondary School Heads
All Others Concerned

1. In reference to **Division Memorandum No. 054, s. 2026**, entitled **“Implementation of Containerized Ube Planting in Schools as an Agricultural Learning Output,”** all public elementary and secondary schools are reminded to continue the implementation of the activity in accordance with the approved **Implementation Timeline provided in Enclosure No. 1** of the said memorandum.
2. Pursuant to the implementation timeline, the month of **August 2026** shall be devoted to the **monitoring of the implementation and initial judging** of the containerized ube planting activities of participating schools as part of the **Division Search for the different contest categories** under the Containerized Ube Planting in Schools initiative.
3. This Office **in coordination with the City Agriculture and Veterinary Office**, shall conduct the monitoring and initial judging from **August 17 to 27, 2026**. The monitoring and initial judging shall serve the following purposes:
 - a. **To monitor the progress and implementation** of the containerized ube planting activity in participating schools;
 - b. **To provide technical assistance and recommendations** on the proper care and maintenance of the growing ube plants;
 - c. **To assess and initially judge the participating schools** for the different contest categories under the Division Search for Containerized Ube Planting in Schools; and
 - d. **To identify schools that demonstrate commendable performance and potential** for recognition in the succeeding stages of the Division Search.
4. The monitoring and initial judging shall focus on the following general areas:
 - a. presence and condition of planted ube plants;
 - b. growth and development of the ube plants, including the presence and development of ube tubers, when applicable;

- c. proper maintenance and care of the plants;
 - d. availability, completeness, and accuracy of records and documentation; and
 - e. general appearance, cleanliness, organization, presentation, and overall management of the containerized ube planting area.
5. The specific criteria, percentage weights, and requirements for the different contest categories shall be based on the approved guidelines and judging criteria for the **Division Search for Containerized Ube Planting in Schools**.
6. The results of the monitoring and initial judging shall serve as a basis for determining the progress of implementation, providing technical assistance, identifying areas for improvement, and determining the initial standing of participating schools in the different contest categories of the Division Search.
7. School heads are advised to ensure that their containerized ube planting areas are properly maintained and that all relevant records, documentation, and other required evidence are available during the scheduled monitoring and initial judging.
8. Immediate and wide dissemination of this Memorandum is desired.
