OF DEPED ORDER NO. 001, S. 2026: IMPLEMENTING
GUIDELINES FOR THE ENHANCED ALTERNATIVE LEARNING
SYSTEM**

DATE : AUGUST 6, 2026

1. DepEd Order No. 001, s. 2026 institutionalizes the Enhanced Alternative Learning System (ALS), aligned with the Revised Basic Education Curriculum and Republic Act 11510 (ALS Act). This order introduces updated program standards, curriculum alignment, assessment mechanisms, and life skills integration.

To ensure effective implementation, it is imperative that ALS teachers fully understand the provisions of the Enhanced ALS guidelines. Cascading this order through Learning Action Cell (LAC) sessions on the following schedule:

2. Participants of the said activity are all ALS teachers handling BLP, Elementary, Junior High School, Senior High School-ALS, and BPOSA teachers, DCPNHS-JHS and SHS Principals and Assistant School Principals, and select Division Personnel.

3. Teaching and non-teaching personnel who will attend the activities scheduled shall be granted the appropriate benefit for services rendered beyond regular working days. Teaching personnel shall be entitled to Vacation Service Credits in accordance with DepEd Order No. 53, s. 2003 (Updated Guidelines on Grant of Vacation Service Credits to Teachers), while non-teaching personnel shall be granted Compensatory Time-Off (CTO) pursuant to CSC-DBM Joint Circular No. 2, s. 2004 (Non-Monetary Remuneration for Overtime Services Rendered), whichever is applicable.
