DIVISION SCIENCE, MATHEMATICS AND TECHNOLOGY FAIR 2026

To: All Public Elementary and Secondary Schools

1. This Office, through the Curriculum Implementation Division (CID) hereby announces the conduct of the **Division Science, Mathematics and Technology Fair 2026** on **September 7-8, 2026 with the theme: "Innovate Today, Inspire Tomorrow"**.

2. The activity aims to:
2.1 develop and strengthen the Science, Technology, Engineering, and Mathematics (STEM) skills of learners through the conduct of research projects that addresses local, national and/or global issues, concerns, and problems;
2.2 provide an avenue for high school learners to communicate research findings and showcase their investigations and innovations to the STEM community and the public;
2.3 foster a culture of creativity and innovation among youth;
2.4 promote STEM awareness and interest among learners, teachers, and the public;
and
2.5 provide opportunity for the collaboration and establish research networks between and among the learners, stakeholders, and the community.

3. A Registration Fee of **Two Thousand Two Hundred Pesos (Php 2,200.00) Per School** will be collected to cover supplies, materials, meals of the Judges, Trophies, Medals, Certificates, Honorarium of the Judges and other expenses relative to the conduct of the activity and shall be charged against School Local Funds/MOOE. Expenses relative to the conduct of the activity are subject to the usual accounting and auditing rules and regulations. Payments can be made in cash and cheque to the DepEd Division of Tagbilaran City. Participants from schools are highly encouraged to pay the registration fee starting **August 12, 2026, to Mrs. Margarita L. Tejano** at SDO Supply Office.

4. The food and travel expenses of the learner-participants and coaches are not covered by the registration and shall be charged to school's local funds/school MOOE. All participants are required to wear a white T-shirt bearing the official logo provided by the division as part of the contest requirements. The cost of printing shall be charged to the school's local funds/school MOOE subject to the usual accounting and auditing rules and regulations.
