3rd SDO TAGBILARAN ROBOTICS CUP 2026

To: All Public Elementary and Secondary Schools
All Private Elementary and Secondary Schools
All Robotics Coordinators
All Others Concerned

1. This Office, through the Curriculum Implementation Division (CID) hereby announces the conduct of the **3rd SDO Tagbilaran Robotics Camp 2024 on October 24, 2026**.
2. The activity aims to:
 - 2.1 *provide opportunities for learners to build and program their robots, applying their learning in real-time;*
 - 2.2 *encourage teamwork through group projects and challenges that require collaboration, communication, and problem-solving; and*
 - 2.3 *inspire creativity by challenging students to design and innovate their robotics projects, encouraging out-of-the-box thinking.*
3. All public elementary and secondary schools are required to participate in the said event.
 - 3.1 *Elementary Schools: Bool ES, Booy ES, Booy South ES, Cabawan ES, City East ES, Cogon ES, Dampas ES, Dao ES, Eastern Cogon ES, Manga ES, Mansasa ES, San Isidro ES, Taloto ES, TCCES, TCC-SPED, Tiptip ES, Ubujan ES;*
 - 3.2 *Secondary Schools: City of Tagb NHS, Cogon NHS, DCPNHS JHS, DCPNHS SHS, Manga NHS, Mansasa NHS, San Isidro NHS, TCSHS and Taloto NHS.*
4. **Private elementary and secondary schools** are hereby invited to participate in the competition, provided that they have the required **LEGO and EVE3 robotics kit**.
5. Each participating school may field a **maximum of two (2) teams** in the competition, with each team composed of **three (3) learners and one (1) teacher-coach**.
6. For Public Schools, participation shall be organized according to the following categories:
 - Category A1 – Public Elementary Schools: Learners in Grades 3, 4, and 5
 - Category A2 – Public Secondary Schools: Learners in Grades 7, 8, 9, and 11

7. For Private Schools, participation shall be organized according to the following categories:

- Category B1 – Private Elementary Schools: Learners in Grades 3, 4, and 5
- Category B2 – Private Secondary Schools: Learners in Grades 7, 8, 9, and 11

8. All participating teams shall comply with the prescribed competition rules, mechanics, technical requirements and safety protocols.

9. Participating in schools shall ensure that their teams meet the prescribed eligibility requirements and are equipped with the required robotics kits and other materials necessary for the competition.

10. The link provided herein contains the competitions guidelines, competition, mechanics filed elements, and playing field specifications for participants reference, preparation, and practice.

A Registration Fee of **One Thousand Two Hundred Pesos (Php 1,200.00) Per School** to be collected to cover the meals, snacks, and honorarium of the Judges and PMTs, Token, Tarpaulin, Trophies and other expenses relative to the conduct of the activity and shall be charged against School Local Funds/MOOE. Expenses relative to the conduct of the activity are subject to the usual accounting and auditing rules and regulations. Payment can be made in cash and cheque to the DepEd Division of Tagbilaran City. Participants from schools are highly encourage to pay the registration fee starting **August 12, 2025 to Mrs. Margarita L. Tejano** at the SDO Supply Office.

12. The food and travel expenses of the learner-participants and teacher-coaches are not covered by the registration and shall be charged to the local school funds/school MOOE subject to the usual accounting and auditing rules and regulations.
