1. The Department of Education (DepEd), through its Regional Offices, continue to strengthen the delivery of quality Kindergarten education by providing teachers with appropriate, contextualized, and accessible learning resources that support effective classroom instruction.
2. In this regard, the **Project DULA Enhanced Kindergarten Blocks of Time aligned with the Three-Term Budget of Work** are now available for field utilization.
