 - Clothes for three days;
 - Personal camping gear;
 - Rice for three days, canned goods, noodles, and biscuits;
 - Compass, whistle, first-aid kit; and
 - Mosquito and insect repellent.

5. Participation of learners in the said activity shall be voluntary. Further, their participation is subject to the approval of the concerned Schools Division Superintendent, following DepEd Order No. 009, s. 2026 titled *Guidelines on the Implementation of the Three-Term School Calendar in Basic Education*.
