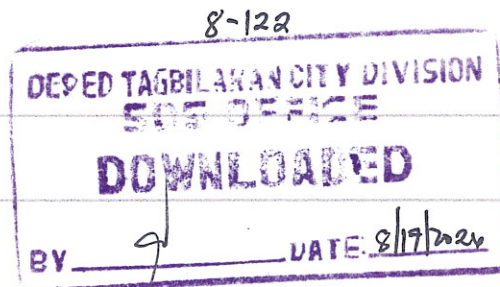

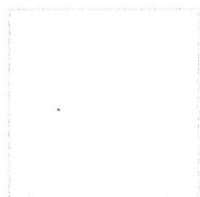

Re: Invitation to Participate in the 29th Philippine Mathematical Olympiad

Dear Sir/Madam,

Greetings of good health this 2026.

The *Mathematical Society of the Philippines* (MSP) is pleased to invite high schools from your division to participate in the **29th Philippine Mathematical Olympiad (PMO)** for the school year 2026-2027.

The PMO, the country's longest-running and most prestigious nationwide mathematics competition for high school students, continues to provide an excellent platform for students to showcase their mathematical abilities. This year, the competition will be held purely onsite. Over 30 official PMO test centers will be available across the country to accommodate students for the exams.

Competition Stages

As in previous PMOs, the competition will consist of three stages:

1. **Qualifying Stage:** 17 October 2026 (Saturday)
2. **Area Stage:** 12 December 2026 (Saturday)
3. **National Stage:** 27-28 February 2027 (Saturday and Sunday)

This tiered structure allows participants to demonstrate their abilities at increasing levels of difficulty and prestige.

Registration and Participation

Each school may register up to 30 high school students (Grades 7–12). The registration fee is **PHP 200 per contestant**.

To begin the registration process, each school must designate a School Coordinator (SC) who will register using [PMO29 Form A](#). Coaches and students may begin training in preparation for the competition. Past contest questions are available at the official [PMO website](#).

Note: If your school wishes to send more than 30 contestants, please email pmo@math.upd.edu.ph for approval. Kindly note that approval is not guaranteed.
