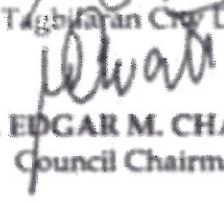
SUBJECT : **PATROL/CREW LEADERS TRAINING COURSES 2026**

1. Encouraging the conduct of Patrol/Crew Leaders Training Courses for the year 2026 prior to the scheduled Institutional or District Encampments, to ensure that Patrol and Crew Leaders are adequately equipped with the necessary knowledge, skills, and leadership competencies to effectively perform their respective roles and responsibilities during the said activities.
2. Interested schools, institutions, & districts, intending to host the said training are requested to coordinate with the Bohol Council, BSP in advance to allow sufficient time for the necessary preparations, scheduling, and logistical arrangements.
3. Qualified to participate are duly registered Boy and Senior Scouts from ages 10 - 18 years old, physically fit as certified by a physician and must have a parent's permit.
4. A registration fee of Three Hundred Pesos (P300.00) will be charged to each participant for the cost of training materials and other administrative expenses. Registration, transportation, meals/snacks on the duration of the training and other incidental expenses related to participation can be charged to the MOOE, SEF, School/District Scouting Funds, or any other available local school funds in accordance with the existing accounting and auditing guidelines. Participants will be responsible for their meals/snacks throughout the duration.
5. Adult Leaders involved in the activity as Training Staff or Accompanying adult shall be granted Service Credits/Compensatory Overtime Credit (COC)/Compensatory Time Off (CTO) in accordance with the existing rules and regulations.
6. All participants shall report to their respective designated venues at 8:00 o'clock in the morning on the first day of the activity for registration, camp set-up, and the opening program. Participants may attend the activity at the venue most accessible and convenient for them.
7. All adult leaders and scouts must strictly adhere to the National Safeguarding Policy of the Boy Scouts of the Philippines to ensure security and safety of all stakeholders.
