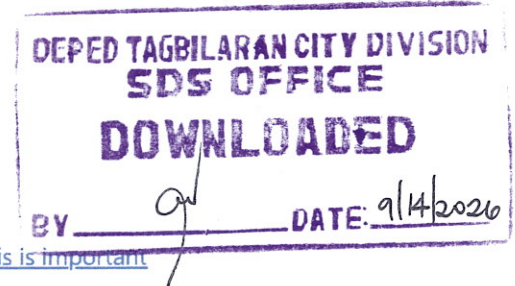

BACKGROUND

The CVPC is the flagship program of the Federation of Accredited Professional Organizations of Region Seven Inc. (FAPOR7). Designed as the first event of its name and kind in the Philippines, it serves as an enabling and integrating platform for all regulated and emerging professions. The convergence aims to gather the 120 to 240 thousand-strong professional community of Central Visayas to exchange the latest scientific advancements and emerging technologies, which are considered vital to the ongoing development of the region.

THEMATIC PRIORITIES

Guided by both the **Philippine Development Plan (PDP)** and the **Central Visayas Regional Development Plan (CV RDP)** steered by the Department of Economy, Planning, and Development (DepDEV) and **Harmonized National Research & Development Agenda (HRNDA)** of the Department of Science & Technology (DOST), we categorized five interlocking development areas as the regional "concern arenas" this first Convergence will surface, structure, and prioritize.

A. Infrastructure, Energy, Water & Digital Connectivity

The RDP lists 28 committed/indicative power projects to shore up thin reserves amid rapid growth. Parallel investments in water security (e.g., integrated water resource management for Metro Cebu and island LGUs), ports, airports, mass transit, and last-mile broadband are essential.

B. Human Capital: Health, Nutrition, Education & Skills

The PDP targets more and better jobs and lower poverty; Region VII's rapid poverty reduction (families: 22%→12.3% in 2023) signals momentum yet highlights the need for sustained investments in basic health, nutrition, TVET/HEI-industry alignment, and worker mobility. In addition, PH unemployment rate for women is at 5.8% higher by 0.8% compared to men on the same period.

C. Food Security & Resilient Agriculture, Aquatic & Natural Resources (AANR)

Regional agriculture shows mixed performance (e.g., rice up, corn down) under pressures from ASF, input costs, and climate variability. Priorities include climate-informed advisories, biosecurity, postharvest, and value-chain integration from Bohol to island municipalities.

D. Climate & Disaster Risk Reduction, Urban Systems & Environmental Stewardship

Urbanization and growth corridors in Cebu-Mandaue-Lapu-Lapu and provincial capitals require risk-sensitive land use, resilient housing, coastal and watershed management, and disaster preparedness core themes in the RDP enabling environment.

E. Competitive & Inclusive Services, Industry, and MSMEs

Central Visayas has been the fastest-growing economy in 2023 (GRDP +7.3%), with Services (~70% GRDP share) as the growth anchor yet quality jobs and firm productivity remain uneven across provinces and value chains. In 2022, 59.5% of businesses registered in the country were by women. Addressing gaps in enterprise upgrading, logistics, digitalization, and standards compliance as well as integration of Diversity, Equity and Inclusion (DEI) programs is pivotal.

ABOUT FAPOR7

The **Federation of Accredited Professional Organizations of Region Seven Inc.** operating under the name **FAPOR7** is a nonstock and nonprofit organization founded on 17 February 2023 and is composed of professional organizations representing the regulated professionals in the Central Visayas. Its aim is to serve as an integrating platform where various professions collaborate in various shared endeavors and provide local support to both its member organizations and the community.

Previously, an umbrella organization for engineering and scientific organizations existed called the Confederation of Scientific and Professional Organizations Region 7, Inc. (COSPO) founded by DOST7 RD Rene Burt Llanto in 1989 and eventually ceased after 2009.

Efforts to federate all the professional organizations of the 46 professions into one umbrella was first proposed by PRC7 Regional Director Narcival Taquiqui in the PRC Stakeholders Meeting on 13 May 2022 and eventually formed the following year.

The Organization was registered and incorporated with the Securities and Exchange Commission (SEC) on 25 December 2025 and its SEC Registration Number 2025120231239-02. It is also registered with the Bureau of Internal Revenue with its Tax Identification Number 010-953-684-000. Its incorporators are also the 12 active professional organizations providing the foundational direction of the organization. It works closely the Professional Regulation Commission Regional Office VII (PRC7) to advance professional practice and leverage the 46 regulated professions of the country in the development of Central Visayas.

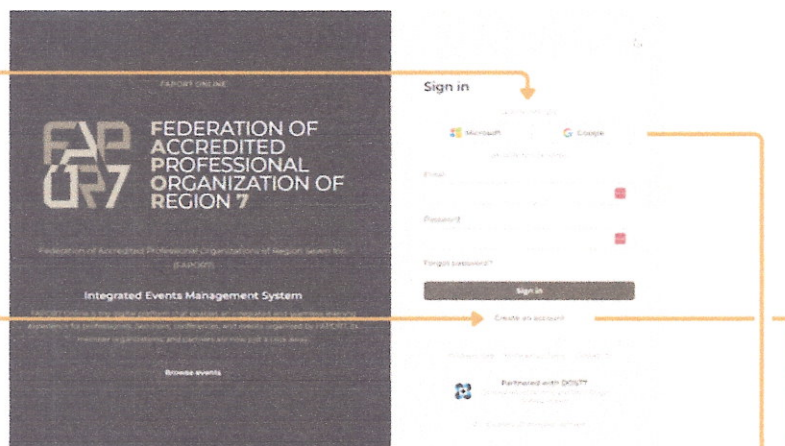

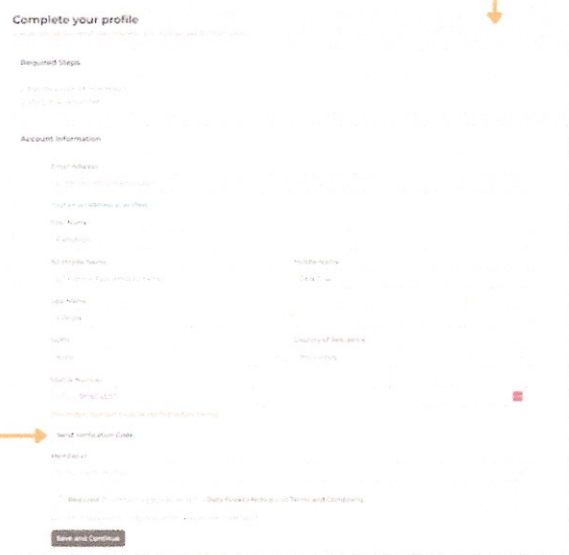
